1. A book entitled Captain Sir Richard Francis Burton was authored by Edward Rice. The publisher of the book is Barnes and Noble, Incorporated and the year of publication is 1990. The information you are citing is found on page 2 and pages 23 through 24.
2. Pocket Books published Susan Sackett's book entitled Star Trek Speaks. Her co-authors were John Smith and James Johnson. She wrote the book with two other authors and it was published in 1979. The citation you formulate must indicate that Susan's book is quoting a line from the tv series Star Trek. The episode cited aired on March 15, 1968 and was called Bread and Circuses. Paramount Pictures is the producer. This quoted material is found on page 52 of Sackett's book.
3. Free Speech In Its Forgotten Years was written by David M. Rabban. In 1997 Cambridge University Press published this book. The information can be found on page six.
4. Alexandre Dumas wrote the Count of Monte Cristo, which was originally published in 1846. The publisher is Oxford University Press and the editor of this edition is David Coward. The information can be found on pages 101 and 104.
5. Tom McEwen wrote The Gators: a Story of Florida Football, which was published in 1974 by Strode Publishing. The information you need can be found on page 76.

6. Marty Cohen wrote *Gator Tales, Stories, Stats, and Stuff About Florida Football*. Witchita Eagle and Beacon Publishing Company published this book in 1995. The cited information is found on page 19.
  
7. W.T. Cash wrote *The Story of Florida*. The information you need is found on page ten. In 1938 the American Historical Society, Incorporated published this book. This was the third volume of the book.
  
8. John Laffin wrote *A Western Front Companion: 1914–1918*. The information you need is on page 94. Alan Sutton Publishing Limited published this book in 1994.
  
9. Vine Deloria, Jr. is the author of *Self Determination and the Concept of Sovereignty*, which is published in *Native American Sovereignty*. Deloria's work begins on page 118 of *Native American Sovereignty*, and the cited information is found on page 118. The editor of *Native American Sovereignty* is John R. Wunder. The book was published in 1996 by Garland Publishing Company Incorporated.
  
10. John Smith wrote *Handbook on Civil Procedure*. This was published in 1982 by Aspen Law and Business. The pertinent section is 50.213.
